Bell is hoping his preparations are enough for Loyal to become only the second yacht to beat Wild Oats in the Sydney to Hobart.

Last year Wild Oats beat Loyal to Hobart by more than three hours in a race made tough by hours of nasty upwind sailing.

Australia's Tom Slingsby won yesterday's medal race to clinch his fourth world title in the laser class at the World Sailing Championships off Fremantle.

The top-ranked Slingsby entered the race needing to finish seventh or better to add to his three world championship gold medals.

The 27-year-old won the race by more than 100m from Britain's Nick Thompson and will go into next year's London Olympics as an overwhelming favourite.

Thompson claimed the silver medal and New Zealand's Andrew Murdoch took the bronze.

Earlier yesterday, Australia's top-ranked pair of Nathan Outteridge and Iain Jensen won the men's 49er skiff class when they finished third out of 10 crews in the medal race.
